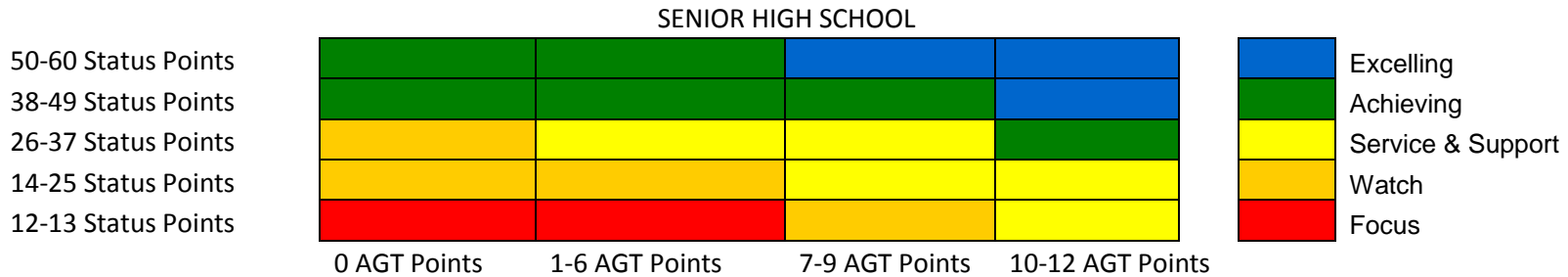

**1 POINT**

1. If less than or equal to 34% of your student body is Proficient or Advanced in ELA according to 2012-2013 CST results (this threshold represents 50<sup>th</sup> percentile performance) you earn 1 point.\*
2. If greater than or equal to 28% of your student body is Far Below Basic or Below Basic in ELA according to 2012-2013 CST results (this threshold represents 50<sup>th</sup> percentile performance) you earn 1 point.\*
3. If less than or equal to 19% of your student body is Proficient or Advanced in Math according to 2012-2013 CST results (this threshold represents 75<sup>th</sup> percentile performance) you earn 1 point. \*
4. If greater than or equal to 54% of your student body is Far Below Basic or Below Basic in Math according to 2012-2013 CST results (this threshold represents 25<sup>th</sup> percentile performance) you earn 1 point.\*

2. If less than or equal to 9% of your student body is Far Below Basic or Below Basic in ELA according to 2012-2013 CST results (this threshold represents 5<sup>th</sup> percentile performance) you earn 5 points.
3. If greater than or equal to 47% of your student body is Proficient or Advanced in Math according to 2012-2013 CST results (this threshold represents the 2013-2014 Performance Meter Target) you earn 5 points. \*
4. If less than or equal to 34% of your student body is Far Below Basic or Below Basic in Math according to 2012-2013 CST results (this threshold represents 5<sup>th</sup> percentile performance) you earn 5 points.\*

9. If greater than or equal to 70% of your 4 year cohort class graduates (this threshold represents the 2013-2014 Performance Meter Target) you earn 5 points.\*
10. If greater than or equal to 84% of your student body passes the CAHSEE on their 1<sup>st</sup> attempt (this threshold represents 90<sup>th</sup> percentile performance) you earn 5 points.\*
11. If greater than or equal to 76% of your student body attends school at least 96% of the school year (this threshold represents the 2013-2014 Performance Meter Targets) you earn 5 points.\*
12. If 0% of your student body has been suspended during the academic year (this threshold represents 25<sup>th</sup> percentile performance), you earn 5 points.
